

-- शहीद भगत सिंह एक असाधारण साहसी और महान देशभक्त थे ।. इनके पिता सरदार किशन सिंह तथा चाचा दोनों ही स्वतंत्रता सेनानी थे । इनके जन्म के समय दोनों जेल में थे । इनका जन्म 27 सितंबर 1907 ई. में लायलपुर जिले में हुआ था । इनके जन्म के दो माह बाद ही इनके पिता तथा चाचा की रिहाई हो गई । दादी ने प्रसन्न होकर इनका नाम 'भागांवाला' अर्थात् भाग्यवाला रखा । यही बालक आगे चलकर भगत सिंह कहलाया । जिस समय इनका जन्म हुआ देश में विद्रोह की ज्वाला धंधक रही थी । वे बचपन से ही असाधारण खेल खेला करते थे । एक बार एक खेत में पाष्ट्री में लकड़ियाँ गाड़ रहे थे । पूछने पर इन्होंने कहा बंदूक बो रहा हूँ । बचपन से ही इनका संपर्क लाला लाजपतराय, करतार सिंह सरामा से हो गया । करतार सिंह से यह बहुत प्रभावित थे । प्रथम लाहौर पद्धांत्र कैस (1915) में यह केवल 9 वर्ष के थे । 1919 में घटित जलियाँवाला बाग कांड ने पूरे देश को झकझोर दिया । भगत सिंह भी उस स्थान पर शहीदों को श्रद्धांजिल देने गए। वहीं पर मिट्टी उठाकर बलिदान की शपथ खाई। 1920 में गाँधी के असहयोग आंदोलन ने जोर पकड़ा। भगत सिंह भी डी. ए. वी. कॉलेज छोड़कर लाला लाजपतराय द्वारा स्थापित नेशनल कॉलेज में भर्ती हो गए । वहीं इनकी भेंट भगवती चरण, सुखदेव, यशपाल आदि क्रांतिकारियों से हुई । वहाँ इन्हें बड़े-बड़े नेताओं का भाषण सूनने को मिला । जयबंद्र विद्यालंकार से यह विशेष प्रमावित थे । विद्यालय में यह देशमक्ति के नाटक खेला करते थे जिसका उद्देश्य लोगों के दिल में राष्ट्रीय चेतना पैदा करना था । इनके विता ने इनसे विवाह करने के लिए कहा तो इन्होंने साफ मना कर दिया और कहा – आप केवल माँ की चिंता करते हैं 33 करोड़ की माँ भारत कितने दुःख में है । इसका दुःख दूर करना मेरा पहला कर्तव्य है, उन्होंने आजीवन विवाह न करने का निश्चय कर लिया । बाद में भगत सिंह कानपूर आए और गणेशशंकर विद्यार्थी के संपर्क में रहकर राष्ट्र की सेवा करते रहे । 1928 में साइमन कमीशन का विरोध करते हुए लाला लाजपतराय अंग्रेजों की लाठी से घायल हो गए और उसमें इनकी मृत्यु हो गई । क्रांतिकारियों ने मिस्टर स्काट की हत्या की योजना बनाई । भगत सिंह का भी नाम उसमें था । एक अंग्रेज कार्यालय से बाहर निकला । क्रांतिकारियों ने उस पर गोली चलाई और वह मारा गया । सभी क्रांतिकारी भाग निकलें । अंग्रेज सार्वजनिक सुरक्षा विधेयक संसद में पेश करना चाहते थे । यह विधेयक सरकार की दमनकारी नीति का पोषक था । 1929 अप्रैल में इसे लागू करना था । क्रांतिकारियों ने असेंबली पर बम फेंकने का निश्चय कर लिया । भगत सिंह सहित चार साथी असेंयली **में प्रविष्ट हुए और उन्होंने वहाँ बम फेंक कर स्वयं गिरफ्तारी दे दी । इन पर मुकदमा चलाया गया । उन पर सांडर्स की हत्या का भी आरोप** था । उन्हें नृत्यु दंड दिया गया । 23 मार्च 1931 को भगत सिंह, सुखदेव तथा राजगुरू को फाँसी दी गई । उनकी माता ने जेल में आकर पुत्र से कहा - 'बेटा हठ मत छोड़ना, एक दिन तो मरना ही है, पर ऐसा मरना जिससे पूरा विश्व याद करके रो उठे ।' तख्ते पर खड़े होकर उन्होंने इंकलाब का नारा लगाया और फाँसी पर झूल गए ।
