



Look at any waste garbage dump. In addition to vegetable scraps, paper and broken glass, you will notice a considerable amount of plastic material such as shampoo bottles, bags, worn out slippers and so on. Vegetable scraps and paper are bio-degradable (that can be made to rot by bacteria) but glass and plastic continue to accumulate and harm the environment. Plastic is often mistaken for food by birds; animals and fish leading to their death. It also chokes sewer pipes and becomes a trap for living beings in pond, rivers and oceans. Investigations have been going on for a long time to produce an environment friendly plastic in the sense that it decays and becomes a part of the soil like rotting vegetable scraps do. Scientists of Imperial Chemical Industries at London have been able to develop a plastic called Biopol. It is manufactured by microbes. Bottles, films and fibres can be made out of it. Fungi and bacteria can eat it and break it down to carbondioxide and water. This new plastic can also be used to make capsules for slow release in the body of some types of medicines and of pesticides in fields.
