After a long time, the elves visited them again. They greeted the elves singing a song.

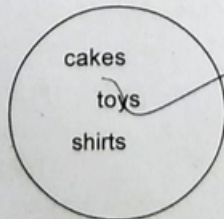
Shoemaker : I am happy to welcome you

The king of the country was very much annoyed and he called the Minister.

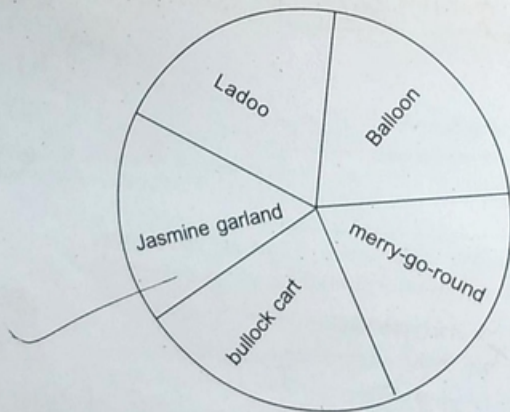
"Your Majesty, Have you called me?"
