During the period of Italian Renaissance, the term 'cartoon' meant the first sketch in actual size of a large work of art, such as a murual (wall painting). When newspapers and magazine began to use drawings to illustrate news and editorial option and to provide amusement, these drawings came to be known as cartoons.

In the days before the newspaper, artists like Hogarth, Daumier and Rowlandson made a series of drawings on a single theme. Sometimes such a series of drawings pictured the adventures of a single character. They were the ancestors
