Activity - 6

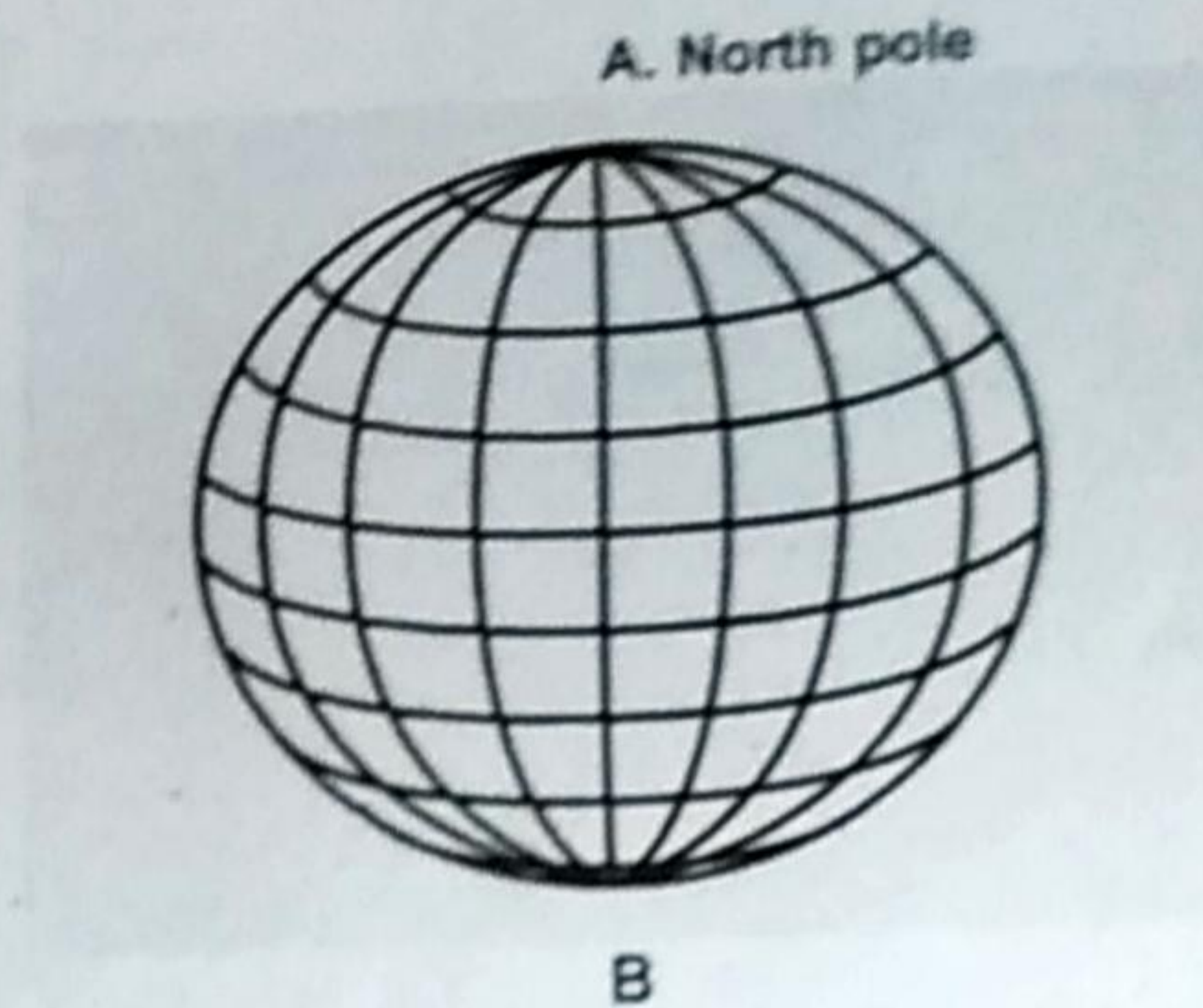
- Once there were abundant paddy fields in Kerala.
