Sample Appreciation

Lines Written in Early Spring

The poem 'Lines Written in Early Spring' is written by the well-known nature poet William Wordsworth. He wrote this poem during the times of French Revolution. The poem deals with the theme of coexistence, peace and pleasure in nature and the cruelties in the human world.

The poet could see how the new twigs spread out their tender leaves to catch the breezy air. The budding twigs are reaching out for happiness. One could see pleasure in each and everything in Nature. The poet says that coexistence is Nature's holy plan. But he laments over the cruelties of man towards Nature and his own kind.

'The budding twigs spread out their fan', 'To catch the breezy air' and 'Nature's holy plan' are examples of personification. 'Budding twigs' create a visual image and 'breezy air' creates a tactile image in our mind. The use of alliteration could be seen in 'What <u>man has made of man'</u>. The poem follows the rhyme scheme 'ab ab'. The rhyming words employed in the poem gives a rhythmic quality to the poem. The poem follows a melancholic tone.

The poet has followed a very simple writing style. This poem is considered as one of the most marvellous and aesthetic poems in English.

One night, when he was sitting in front of the mirror in his room in a flight of fancy, a big cobra slithered along his shoulder and coiled around his left arm. Though he had to sit like a stone image in flesh, he did not lose his presence of mind. In the helpless situation he could not but rely on the mercy of God, and he pathetically scribed the words 'O God' on the walls of his heart, though he had not been religious till then.
