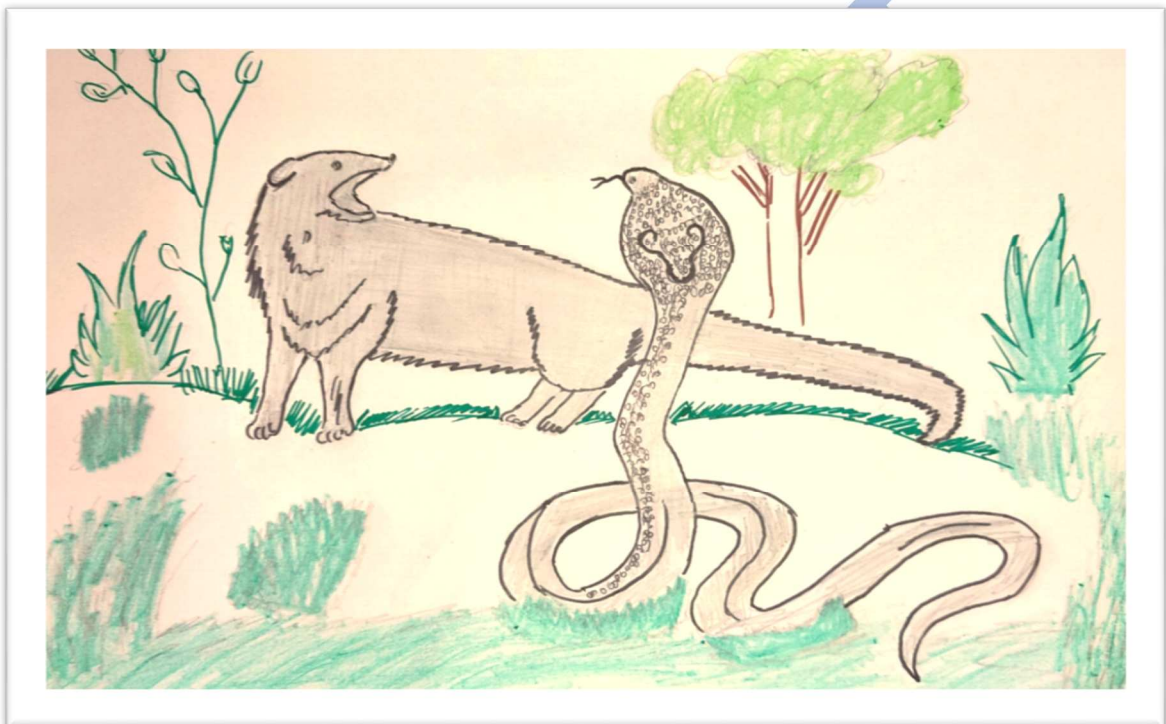


8. Imagine that you visited English Garden made by the Grandfather. Prepare **five questions** that you would ask him during the visit.
