Jamini Roy - The folk icon of Indian Art .

Jami Roy was born in Baliyathur village in Bangura District of Northern Bengal, which is well known for unique folk Art. Jami lived with 'pathwa' folk artists. He was very fond of their work style and the colours they used. He wished to be an artist. Then he went to Calcutta at the age of sixteen to learn Art. He got well-versed training in western style of painting. After a long search for a unique and indigenous style, he noticed the simple and powerful lines of 'pathwa' method. Jamini then joined with the pathwa' artists of his own village and studied their style. He gave up expensive European colours and started using natural pigments extracted from earth, vegetables, lampblack and started to paint on cloth, wood and lime coated mats instead canvas. Jami called this style as 'flat technique's.
