Each question carries 2 scores. (2 × 4 = 8)

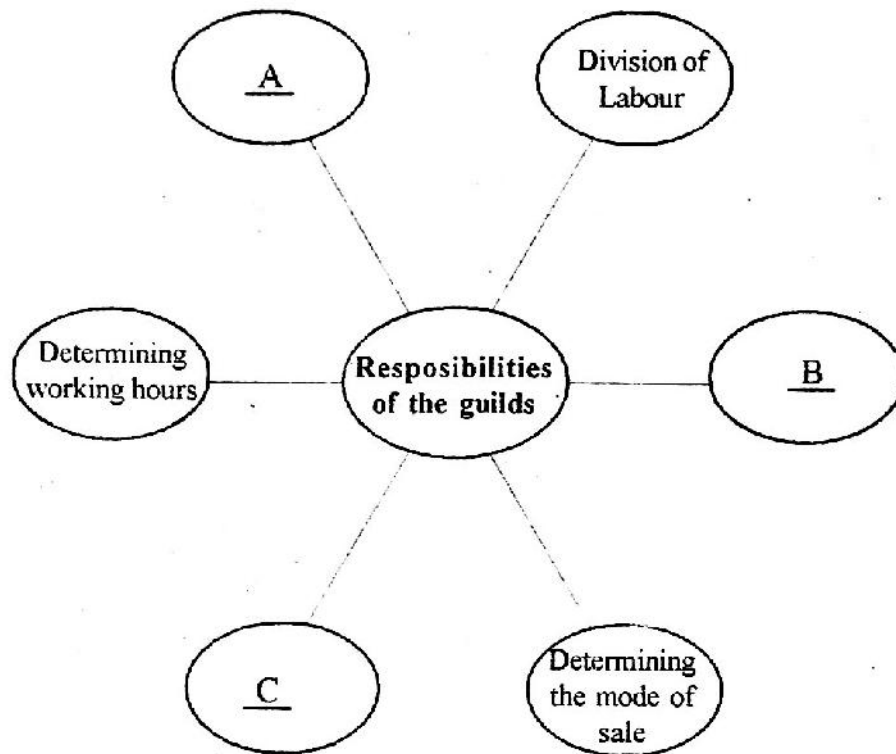
4. Write any two features of Directive Principles of Indian Constitution.
