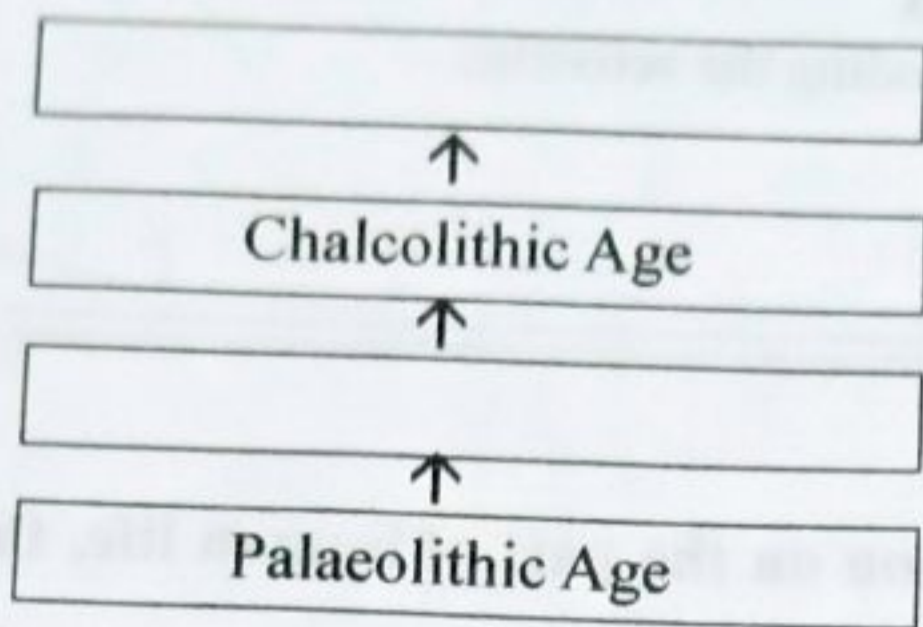

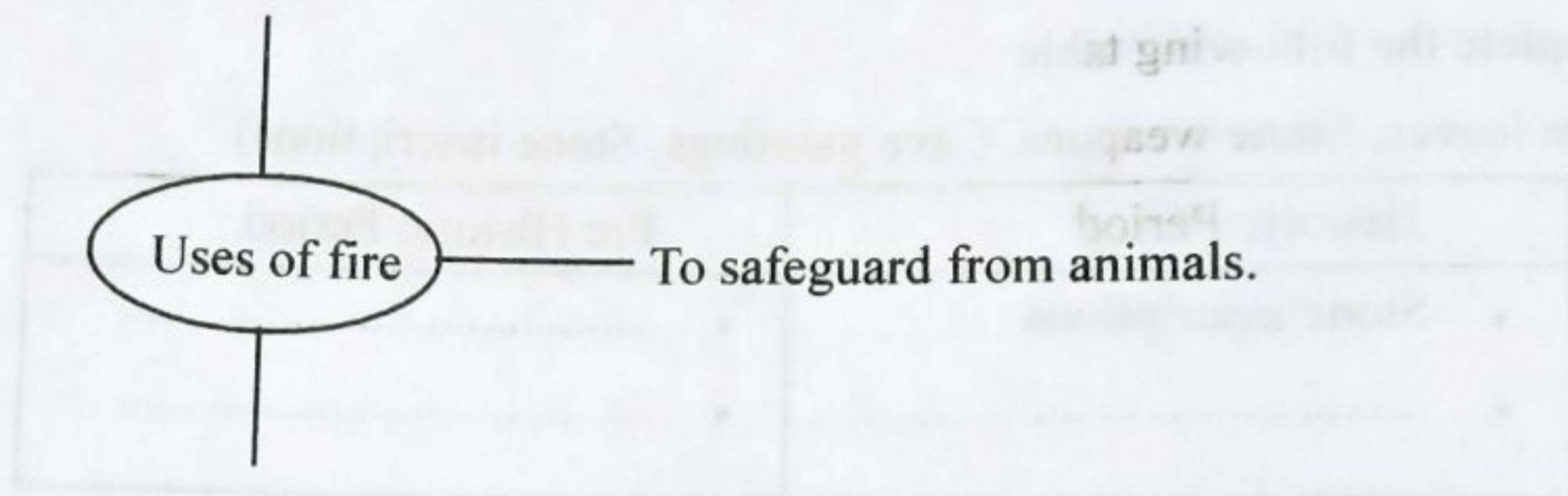
Stone was the material that influenced the early human life the most.

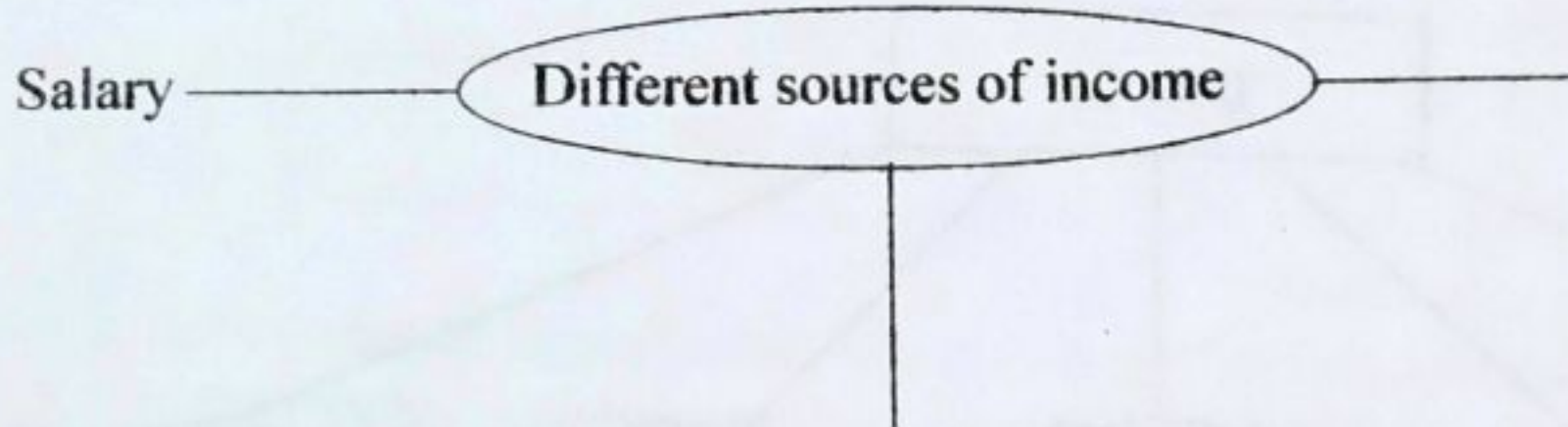
**The fertile soil of river valleys and ample irrigation helped in improving agriculture.**
