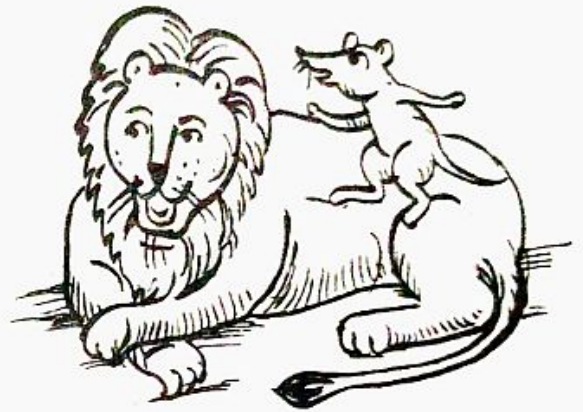

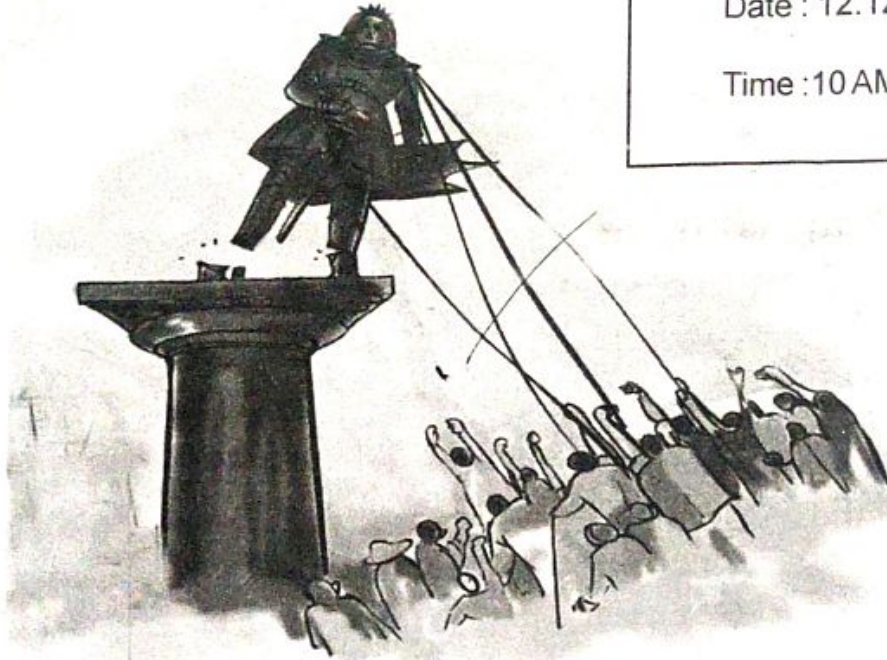
The mayor of the city decided to remove the statue of the happy prince. So he planned to conduct a meeting to discuss it.
