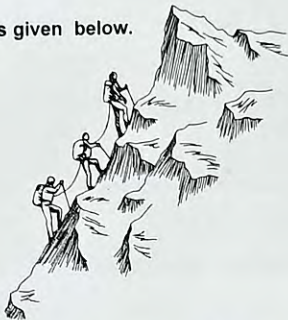
### Activity I Reading Comprehension
