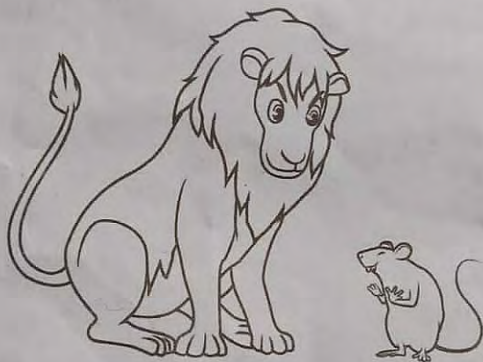
Activity V - Reading Comprehension
