Theme : Love, care and attention

Entry activity

Ask students, "what is love?"
Write their answers on a chart.
Discuss the different ideas
and clarify that love can be
for family, friends, pets and
even things we enjoy.

Feeling the warmth.

Ask students to close their
eyes and imagine a time they
felt loved. What did it feel
like? (warm, happy, safe).
Explain that love can bring a
feeling of warmth inside us.

Teacher presents the picture
of TB page no: 9 in ICT. Tr
asks the students to watch
the picture carefully.

Tr asks some interaction questions
⇒ How many characters are there in this picture?
⇒ Who are the characters in the
picture?

⇒ What are they doing?
⇒ Are they happy?
