A FRIEND

Theme : Love and Care

Learning objectives:

- Read a poem and appreciate it
- Acquire more adjectives / noun
- Identify the rhyming words
- Understand the likes and dislikes of their friends through interaction.

Materials required : / Learning aids

- Textbook
- Chart Paper
- Marker
- ICT

Process

Introduction :

Begin by asking students what a friend is. Record their answers on the board. Then introduce the poem 'A Friend' and tell them that it is about friendship.

Reading the poem:

Have students read the poem silently to themselves. Then read the poem aloud as a class, stopping to discuss any unfamiliar words or phrases.

Scaffolding questions:

- 1) What is the main theme of the poem?
- 2) How does the poem make you feel about friendship?
- 3) What are some of the qualities of a good friend as described in the poem?

Let the students share their thoughts about the poem.

Let them share their stories with the class

Activity - 1

After reading the poem let the children do this activity individually.

Introduce new words related to the qualities of good friend.

Activity - 2

Teacher gives the speciality of rhyming words in their pronunciation.

Let them read the poem again and find the rhyming words individually.

Invite the students to present their findings.

Teacher consolidates by writing them on a chart

Activity 3 -

Divide the children into two member groups.

Let the children ask likes and dislikes of their pair in groups.

Let them write the main likes and dislikes individually

Teacher focus on structure does/ doesn't.

Extended activity:

Write a poem/story on the topic 'Friend'
