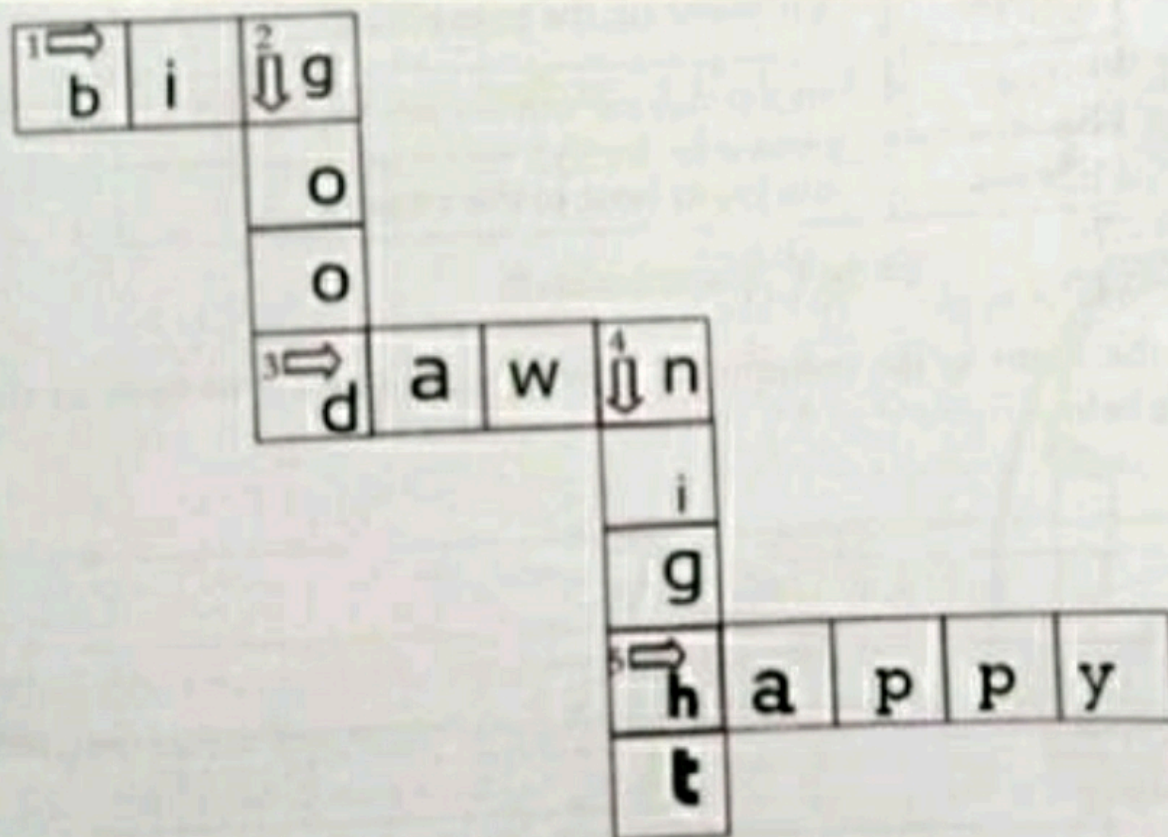


## ACTIVITY 2

Dear diary,

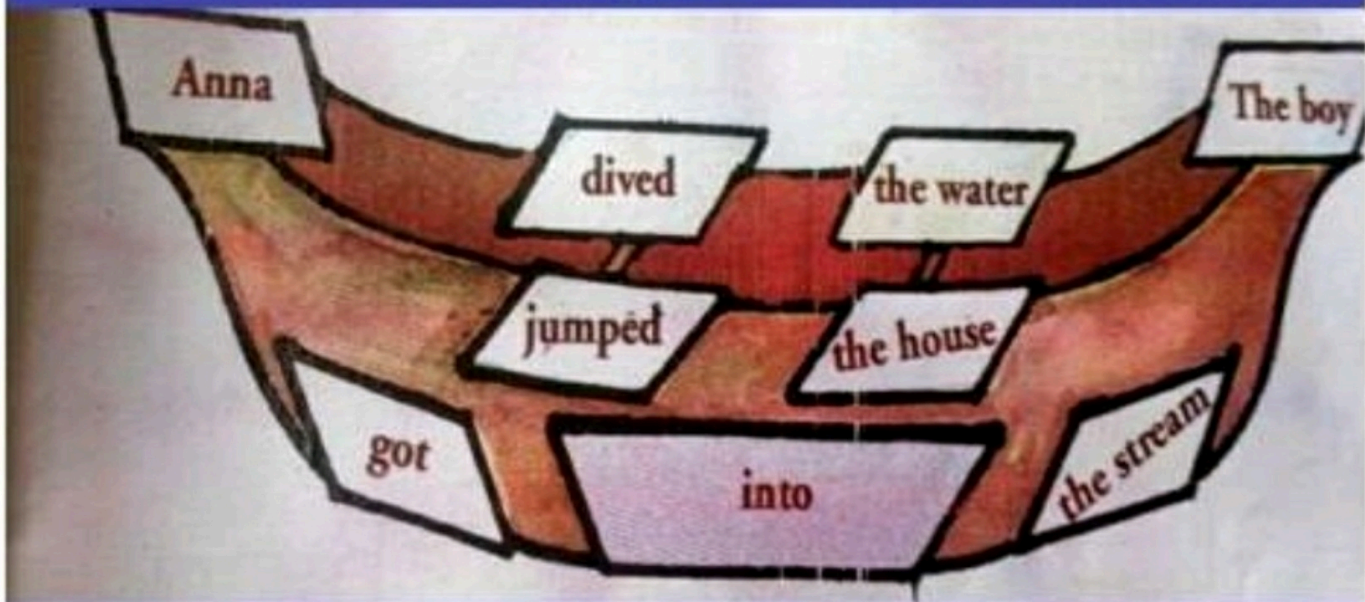
