and extensive surgical trauma the patient is often in worse shape after the operation than before. The first few days after an operation are most dangerous. During this critical period, the patient is under constant surveillance in the post anaesthetic recovery room or in an intensive care unit. Specially trained nurses and doctors use electronic monitoring devices to detect deviations in the patient's vital functions. Closed-circuit television cameras allow constant observation of the patient, but the keen senses of a skilled nurse are still required to ensure the best after-care of the sick.
