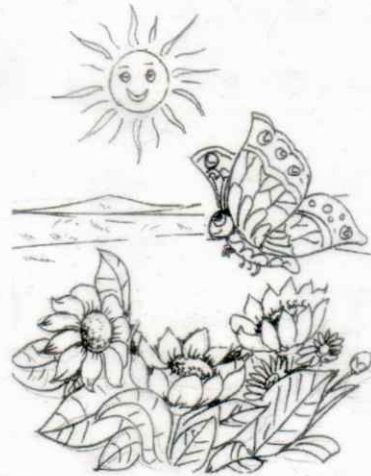

And fill our hearts with joy and pride.

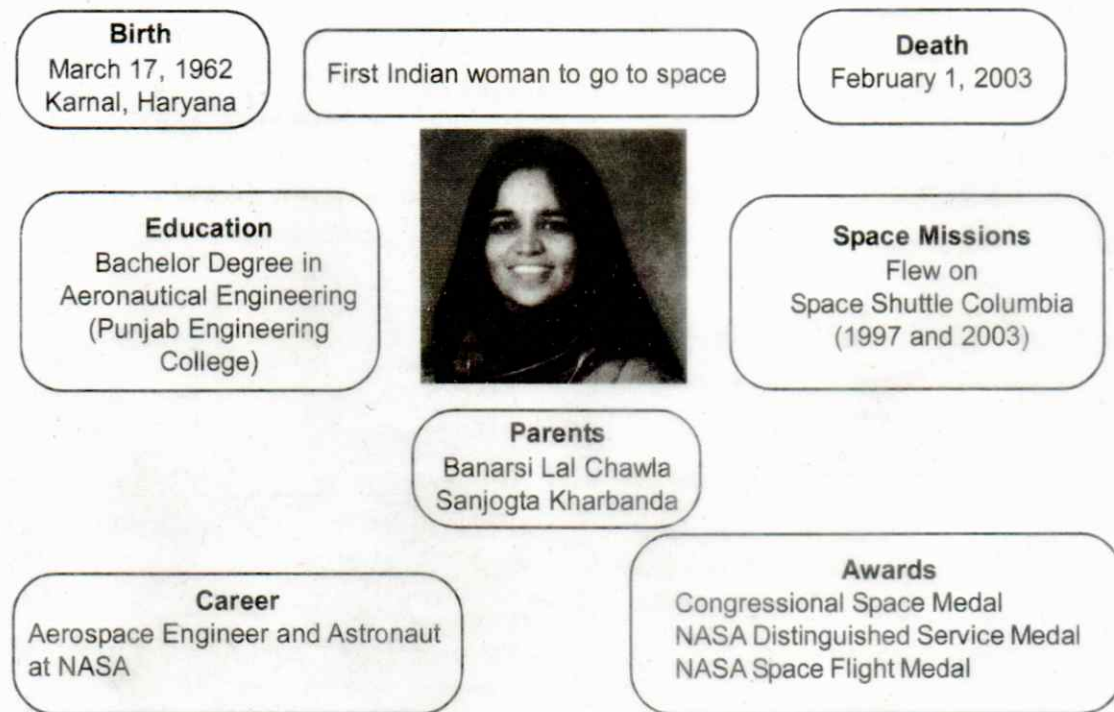
