- The Downloaded Application is mainly intended for candidates who do not claim any reservation benefit or those belonging to Non-Keralite category.
- The Downloaded Application, duly filled in should be accompanied by a Demand Draft for **Rs.700/-** (Rupees Seven Hundred only) drawn on a Nationalised Bank, in favour of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, payable at Thiruvananthapuram.
- Candidates opting DUBAI as the centre for the examination, should submit a Demand Draft for **Rs.7000/-** (Rupees Seven Thousand only) drawn on a Nationalised Bank, in favour of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, payable at Thiruvananthapuram as centre fee, in addition to the application fee of **Rs.700/-** as mentioned above. These candidates should write 'DUBAI' against item 1 ('Centre chosen') in the application form and 'DUB' against item 7 of the Computer Data Sheet.
- The Downloaded Application will have a total of 12 pages, Viz:- Main application (5 pages), Computer Data sheet (1 page), Check list (1 page) and Instructions for filling the application form (5 pages).
- A copy of the Prospectus is available in the site in PDF format. The candidate can download the Prospectus and use for personal reference in the form of printout or softcopy.
- Candidates applying for B.Arch. course only should fill the application form and attach a Demand Draft for Rs.700/- (Rupees Seven Hundred Only) drawn on a Nationalised bank in favour of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, payable at Thiruvananthapuram and submit to the CEE on or before 29-2-2008, 5pm. There is no separate entrance examination for admission to B.Arch course. However, such candidates have to appear for the 'National Aptitude Test in Architecture' (NATA) conducted by the National Institute for Advanced Studies in Architecture (NIASA). Such candidates should also forward the copy of their NATA score card and copy of the mark list of the qualifying examination to the CEE so as to reach him on or before 12-06-2008 for preparation of the Architecture Rank List.
