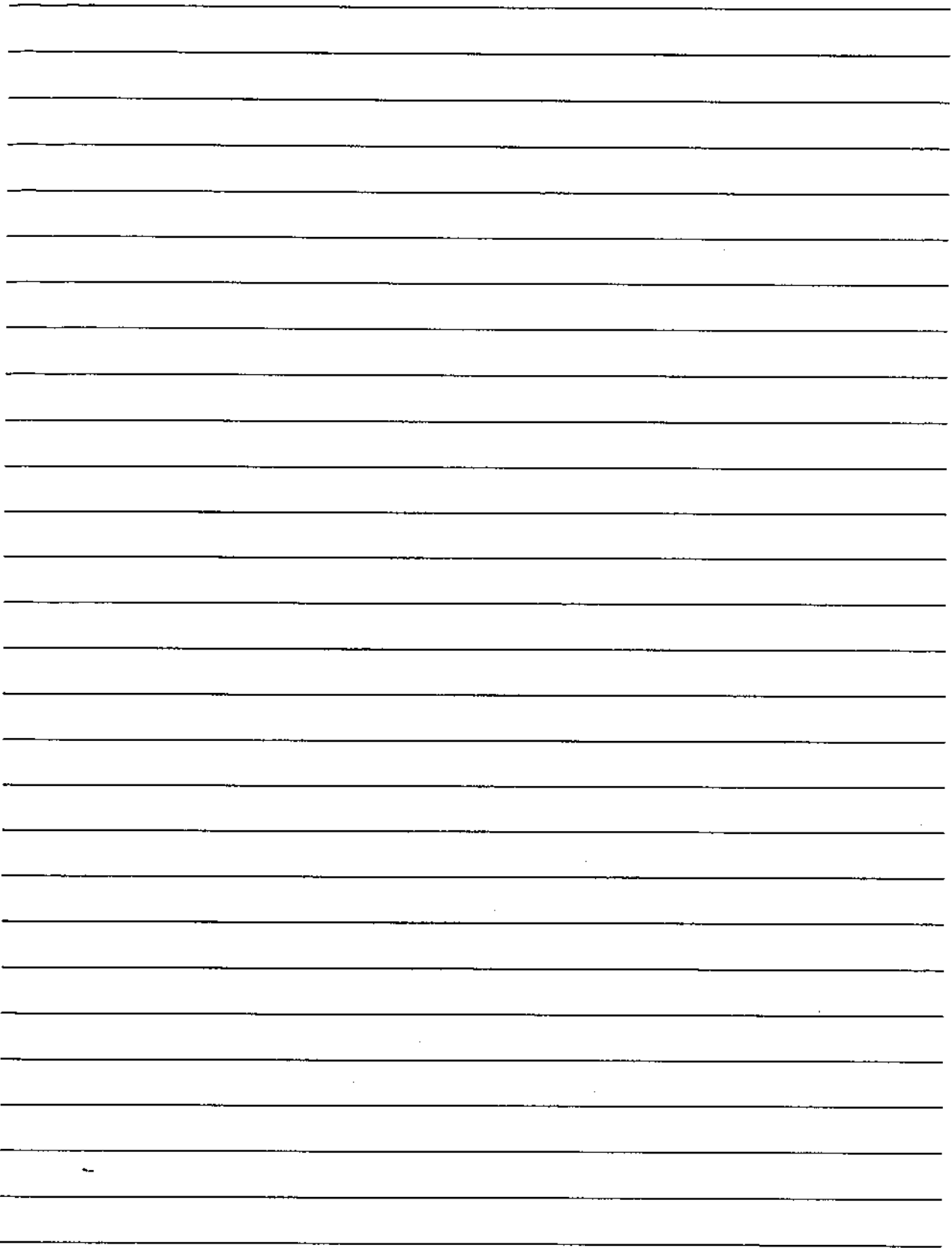

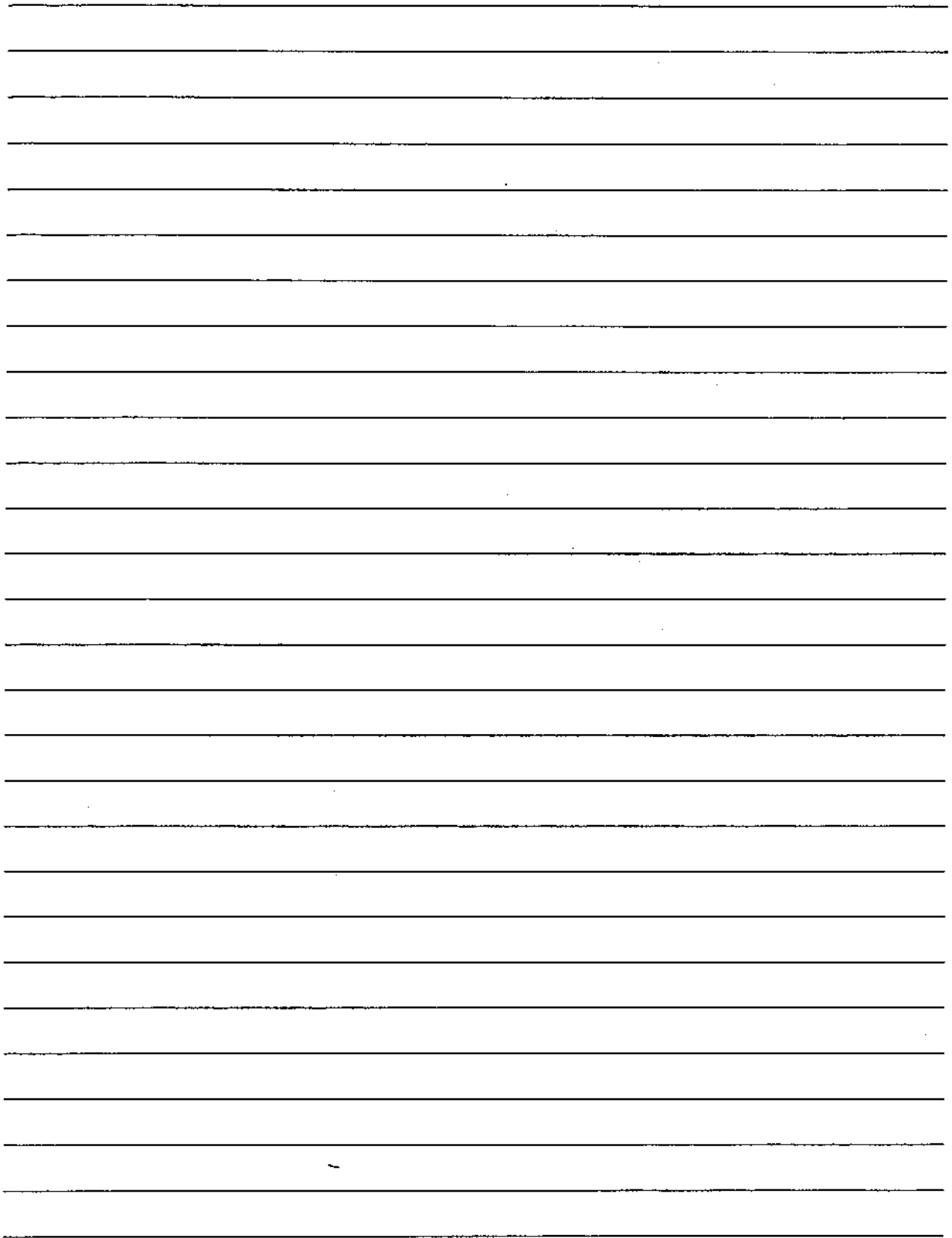

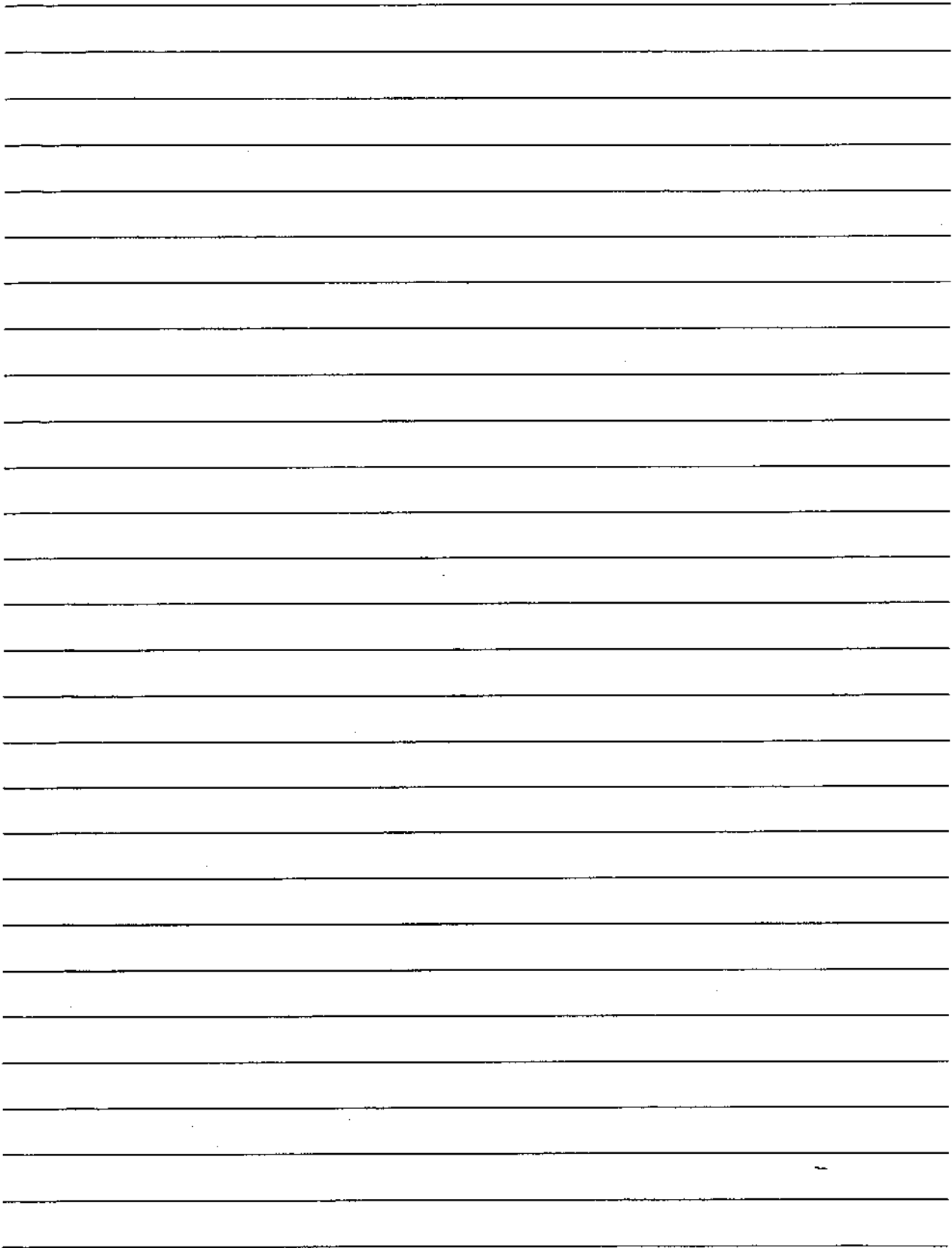




36. 'The function of biography is to 'transmit personality', to rebuild a living man from dead bones'. State in the light of the statement if Boswell has succeeded in his objective ?
